1. On the "My FAFSA" page, under the 2023-24 tab, scroll down the page and click "View Student Aid Report (SAR)."

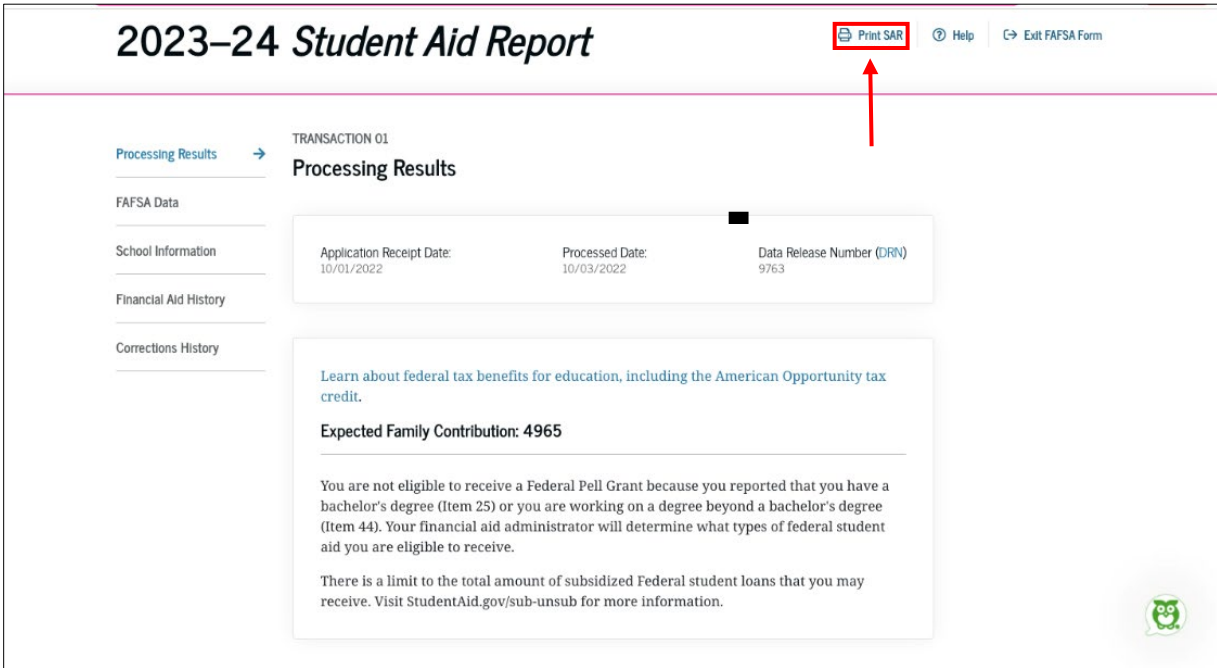

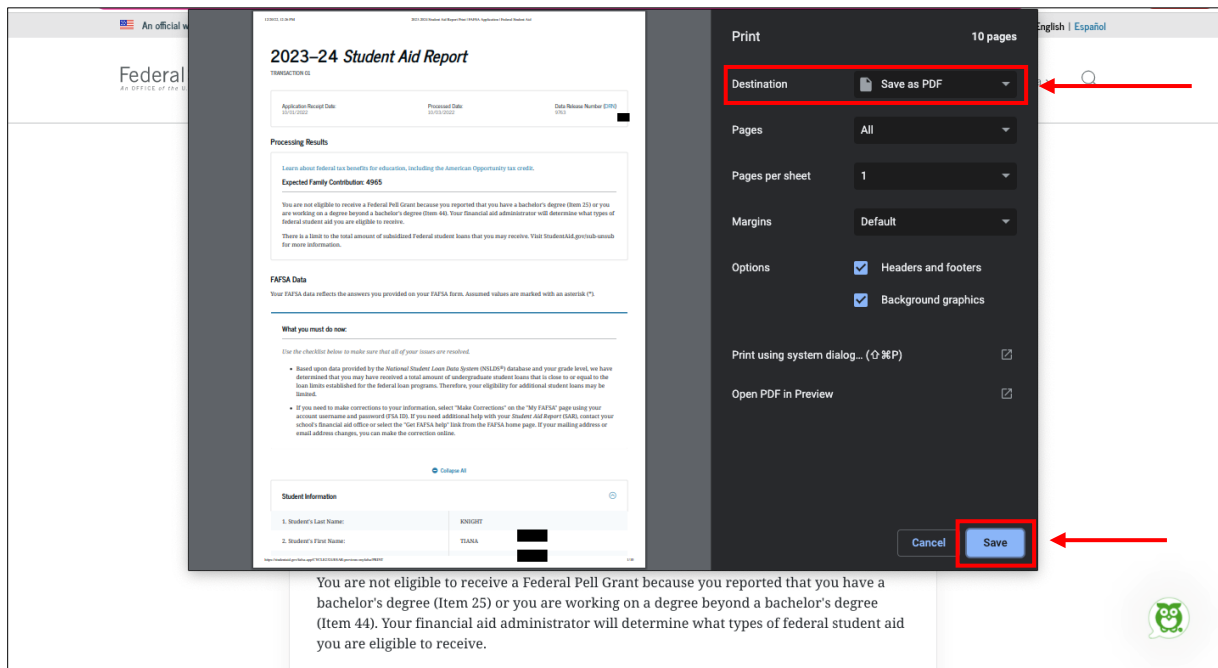
